

# **Endline Evaluation of Training, IEC and NGO Schemes of IPPIX, Government of Karnataka**

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Abstract : The Endline Evaluation of Training, IEC and NGO Schemes of IPP-IX was done during 2001. The data for this study were collected both from primary and secondary sources and the analysis brought out that the training component had achieved its project objectives. The study has shown that, in general, the quality of the training programme. More than 80 per cent of the health personnel working in PHCs and sub-centres had undergone training during the project period. The Health Department need to strengthen their efforts to sustain the training capability and infrastructure developed by the IPP-IX. The survey indicated that the level of awareness among public regarding permanent and temporary methods of family planning, preparation of ORS at home, etc., was very high in rural areas. There was a need for more concerted and effective campaign to create awareness of the crucial aspects of RCH. Some of the innovative schemes had succeeded in achieving IPP – IX project aims and NGOs had been able to organize various IEC programmes with community participation. This had succeeded in imparting health messages to rural women.
