1. Eligibility Criteria

1.1. Professor: Centre for Ecological Economics and Natural Resources

Essential Qualification:

- i. Master's degree in Economics with specialisation in Environment and Ecology with 55% marks in the aggregate or equivalent grade.
- ii. An eminent scholar with Ph.D in Environmental/ Ecological Economics or related topics, preferably with course work in Environmental/ Ecological Economics and published work with a minimum of 10 publications as research articles in refereed journals with impact factor, books from international, Category A, Category B etc publishers as given in API score.
- iii. A minimum of ten (10) years of teaching or research experience in University / Research Institutions / Colleges, and / or experience in research in a regular faculty position, not less than 5 years as Associate Professor at the University/ National level institutions / including experience of guiding candidates for research at Doctoral Level with evidence.
- iv. A minimum score of 360 according to score card approved by ISEC during the preceding calendar years (January 1 to December 31) during the period 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 (to be filled in the attached Excel Sheet and submitted as soft copy).

Desirable Qualification: Experience in the following areas:

- a) Environmental/ Ecological Economics with the knowledge of Environmental Valuation
- b) Natural Resource Economics

An eminent scholar with Ph.D in Education/ Economics/ Sociology/ Psychology preferably with course work in Education and published works in Education with a minimum of 10 publications as research articles in refereed journals with impact factor, books from international, Category A, Category B etc publishers as given in API score
- iii. A minimum of ten (10) years of teaching or research experience in University / Research Institutions / Colleges, and / or experience in research in a regular faculty position, not less than 5 years as Associate Professor at the University/ National level institutions / including experience of guiding candidates for research at Doctoral Level with evidence.
- iv. A minimum score of 360 according to score card approved by ISEC during the preceding calendar years (January 1 to December 31) during the period 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 (to be filled in the attached Excel Sheet and submitted as soft copy).

Desirable Qualification:

- a) The candidate should have substantial experience working in areas of Economics of Education/Sociology of Education/Psychology of Education/Education finances
- b) The candidate should have quality publications in reputed National and International Journals in the above-mentioned areas
- c) The candidate should have collaborative research projects at National /International level in the above-mentioned areas.

1.3 Professor: Centre for Political Institutions, Governance & Development

Essential Qualification:

- i. Master's degree in the discipline of Political Science/ Public Administration with above 55% marks in the aggregate or equivalent grade.
- ii. An eminent scholar with Ph.D in Political Science/ Public Administration preferably with course work in Political Science/ Public Administration and published work in the above subjects with a minimum of 10 publications as research articles in refereed journals with impact factor, books from international, Category A, Category B etc publishers as given in API score.

- iii. A minimum of ten (10) years of teaching or research experience in University / Research Institutions / Colleges, and / or experience in research in a regular faculty position, not less than 5 years as Associate Professor at the University/ National level institutions / including experience of guiding candidates for research at Doctoral Level with evidence.
- iv. A minimum score of 360 according to score card approved by ISEC during the preceding calendar years (January 1 to December 31) during the period 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 (to be filled in the attached Excel Sheet and submitted as soft copy).

Desirable Qualification:

- a) Specializations in Indian Government and Politics/ Comparative Politics/ Politics of Developing Countries.
- b) Conducting independent research and capacity to supervise Doctoral research, with evidence of having supervised Doctoral research.

2.1 Associate Professor: Centre for Decentralisation and Development:

Essential Qualification:

- i. Master's degree in Economics or Sociology or Political Science/ Public Administration with above 55% marks in the aggregate or Equivalent grade.
- ii. Good academic record with a Ph.D degree in the above subjects preferably with course work in the Decentralisation and Development.
- iii. A minimum of seven (7) years of teaching / research experience in University/ Research Institutions / Colleges, and / or experience in research in a regular faculty position of which not less than 5 years as Assistant Professor at the University/National level institutions, excluding the period of PhD research.
- iv. A minimum score of 270 according to score card approved by ISEC during the preceding calendar years (January 1 to December 31) during the period 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 (to be filled in the attached Excel Sheet and submitted as soft copy).

Desirable Qualification:

- a) Multi-disciplinary research on Decentralisation and Development supported by documentary evidence.
- b) PhD degree should preferably be on fiscal, political and administrative aspects of decentralization and development, and local organizations such as PRIs, NGOs and CBOs.
- c) Hands-on experience of MS Excel/ SPSS/ STATA/ any other statistical packages. Experience in application of GIS & RS.

2.2 Associate Professor: Centre for Study of Social Change and Development.

Essential Qualification:

- i. Master's degree in Sociology/Social Anthropology/Social Work with above 55% marks in the aggregate or Equivalent grade.
- ii. Good academic record with a Ph.D degree in Sociology/Social Anthropology/Social Work preferably with course work in the above subjects. A minimum of seven (7) years of

teaching / research experience in University/ Research Institutions / Colleges, and / or experience in research in a regular faculty position of which not less than 5 years as Assistant Professor at the University/National level institutions, excluding the period of PhD research

iii. A minimum score of 270 according to score card approved by ISEC during the preceding calendar years (January 1 to December 31) during the period 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 (to be filled in the attached Excel Sheet and submitted as soft copy).

Desirable Qualification:

Specialization in any of the following areas supported with evidence of successful completion of research projects and publications:

- a) Marginalities: Caste, ethnicity, religion, gender.
- b) Medical sociology: Sociology of health and illness, social gradients of health
- c) Sociology of work: labour processes, labour relations, work-life balance, migration and development
- d) Economic Sociology
- e) Social change and development: Equity and social justice, social inclusiveness and mobility.
- f) The candidate should be well versed in social theories and qualitative methodology. Proven experience in winning and successfully undertaking externally funded national and international research projects
- Eligibility: 50% marks in the aggregate in the Master's degree for SC/ST posts.

3 Last Date for submission of application

4 List of Documents

The applicants shall submit the duly filled in applications in the prescribed form and furnish the information as per the MS Excel (This Excel sheet should not be modified by deleting or adding any row or column) file format which is uploaded in ISEC website, appropriate for the position.

The hard copy of documents submitted in support of API Scores should be year wise, paginated and please mention the respective row and column number of the API score sheet (preferably bounded). The soft copy of the API Score sheet can be sent by Email: recruitment@isec.ac.in.

5. Method of Selection

All the applications shall be authenticated and evaluated by the IQAC and authenticated as per the IQAC regulatory panel and Assessment Committee as approved by the Board.

The API scoring pattern for direct recruitment to be used by IQAC as specified in the IQAC regulations passed by the Academic Council and approved by the Board.

The minimum API score for the post of Professor and Associate Professor shall be 360 & 270 respectively, during the assessment period of any three years in the immediately preceding period of five calendar years.

All the candidates appearing for the Interview for the above posts shall be required to make a 30 minute presentation before the Faculty members of the Institute.

The appointment to the above posts shall be made with probation of Two (2) years from the date of joining.

If you are working in a Govt./ Semi Govt. /Public Sector undertaking and your application have not been forwarded through the proper channel, you are required to bring a **No Objection Certificate** from your present employer during the time of the Preliminary Interview, failing which you may not be allowed for the recruitment process.
