The Research score for research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters/ SCOPUS list):

| i) | Paper in refereed scopus journals without impact factor | - | 2.5 Points |
| ii) | Paper with impact factor less than 1 | - | 05 Points |
| iii) | Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 | - | 10 Points |
| iv) | Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 | - | 15 Points |
| v) | Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 | - | 20 Points |
| vi) | Paper with impact factor >10 | - | 25 Points |
- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.
- Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each

Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the faculty, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of twenty percent of the total research score of the faculty concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
