Subject: Establishment of Students' Welfare Cell (SWC) at ISEC

One of the important mandates of ISEC constitutes organization and running of Ph.D programmes in different disciplines of social sciences. The Institute's students comprise both full-time and part-time scholars and stay on campus as well as outside. Besides this the Institute also organises and conducts various Internship and Certificate Courses.

It is felt necessary to put in place a system to take care of various welfare issues of the students. Hence, in exercise of the power and functions laid down vide item (xix) Section (III) (II) of the Bye-Laws and Service Rules of ISEC (Revised 2022), I constitute "**STUDENTS' WELFARE CELL**" at ISEC led by One Senior Coordinator and supported by one Associate Coordinator, ensuring that at least one of them is a lady faculty.

The responsibilities of the 'Students Welfare Cell' shall be as follows;

1. To facilitate various sports and games activities on the campus, as also for representing ISEC in competitions held outside the Institute.
2. To facilitate the student community undertake various cultural and social service activities on the campus, and also representing ISEC in competitions held outside the Institute.
3. To hear and help the student community to sort out their issues relating to academics, research, etc. such as clearance of scholarships etc.
4. To facilitate the student community network with ISEC's alumni network.
5. Any other relevant issues concerned with student community's.

In case of any doubt, the Coordinators may approach the Director, ISEC. This system has been worked out and finalised, and notification issued in consultation with the Chairman, BoGs, ISEC, Bengaluru.

This shall come into effect immediately after the nominations of the two coordinators.
